Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone By: JK Rowling **Book Club** Grade Level: 5 / Guided Réading Level: Instructional Focus Instructional Focus: Making Inferences Background: Description of the Making an inference means using what you know to make a guess about what you don't know. Sometimes we call this "reading between the lines". Good Instructional Focus readers use the clues in the text, along with their own experiences, to help them figure out things that are not directly said. Making inferences will allow students to read the text more critically. When inferring, we make predictions based on evidence from the text itself, so it will be important to ask students to find passages from the text that shaped their inference. Through making inferences and predictions about text, readers are able to engage more deeply with the text and draw conclusions about characters, events, and the author's purpose.
