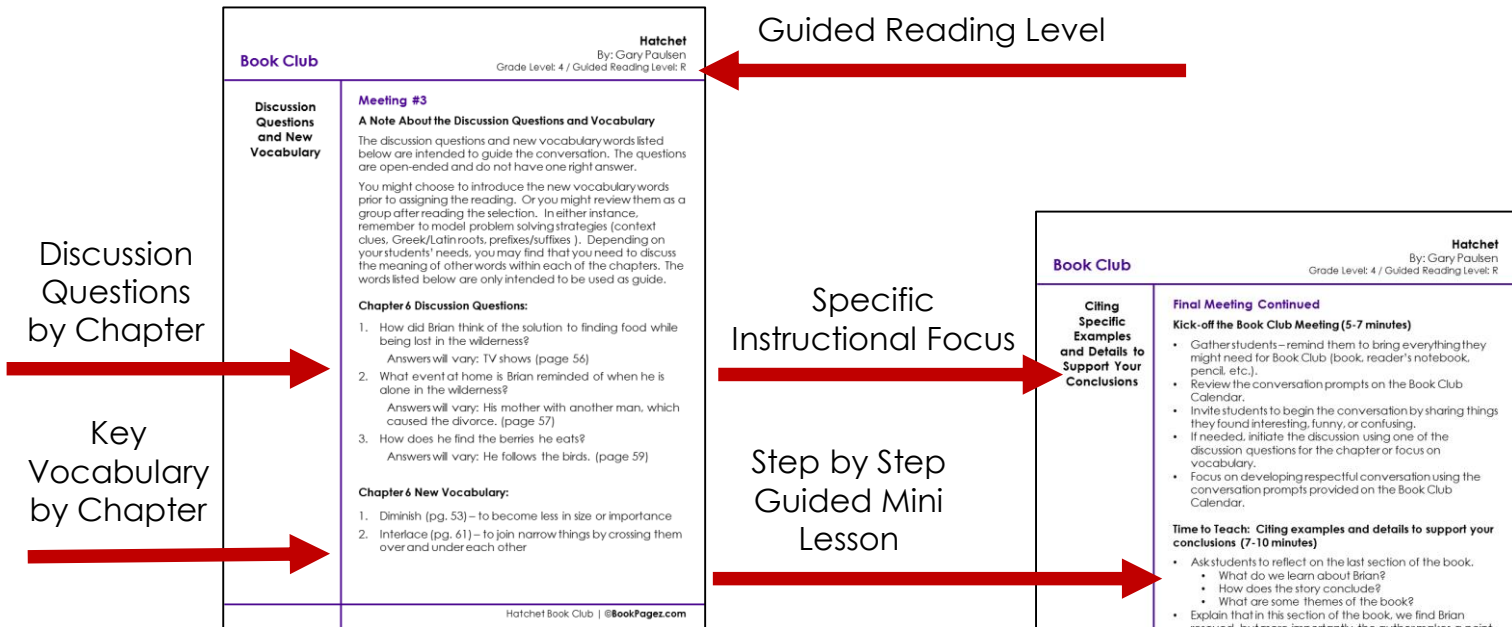


Drawing Conclusions Lesson Plans for 5 Book Club Meetings
