It is the idea the writer wishes to convey about the subject—often Instructional Focus representing the writer's view of the world or a revelation about human nature. Theme is determined by evaluating how characters change and the focus of the Theme is NOT: expressed in a single word the purpose of a work the moral the conflict The way the person tells the story is influenced by their role in the story. A character's point of view may change based on how that character faces and reacts to trouble.
