Instructional Focus:

Determine a theme of a story, drama, or poem from details in the text; summarize the text.

Background:

In literature, the central idea, or subject, that is being written about is the theme of the text. The theme is often repeated throughout the story and the author can choose to state it directly or indirectly. Additionally, a text can have multiple themes.

Themes help to organize the story and provide the reader with something to think about and learn from as they follow the characters throughout the text. As readers are able to sustain comprehension across longer texts, they will begin to be able to identify the theme of the story and notice how the author develops the theme through the characters' dialogue and actions, and the other story elements.
