Tell the students that you are going to read the book once from beginning to end. Tell them to listen and look for words that have a /th/ digraph. Remind them to be polite and not to interrupt you while you read.

Divide students into pairs.

Provide each pair with a set of //th/ picture cords (cut the cards in advance) and a sorting mat.

Show students how to match an image with the correct column on the mat [initial]. You can encourage students to also discuss whether or not they have a soft or hard //th/ **Guided Word Work Practice** to also discuss whether or not they near a surror navary would.

Explain that this activity works best if you talk with you partner and say each I/N word or to load a you work on categorizing.

Set a timer for the activity (10-15 minutes).

Visit each pair as they work. Discuss the correct answers at the end of the activity with the whole group. 1 Q **Practice Page** Give each student a copy of the Digraph /th/ practice page.

 Tell the students to complete the practice Independent Word Work page.

Monitor students while they work. Step 5: Bring the students back together.

Ask students to explain what they learned about words based on the work they completed.

Invite students to turn and talk with a partner about their word. Reconnect and Reflect on Word work.

Invite 2-3 students to share what they learned with the group. Extension Activity Ask students to be on the lookout for words with digraph /th/ in their own reading. Tell them to write their words on a sticky note and add them to the anchor chart freview the added sticky notes with the class later in the day or before moving on to the next word work lesson).

Alternatively, students can keep track of the words using the word before the worksheet.
