Making Inferences

Background:

Making inferences is an essential skill for reading critically. This strategy allows the reader to go from simply reading the words on the page, to becoming immersed in the story. In order for readers to make logical inferences, they must combine the clues in the text, with their own related knowledge, to form an idea about what the text is truly saying.
