#### Directions for the teacher:

- Cut the cards apart and mix them up.
- Distribute one card to each student, making sure each student can read the words on their card.
  - Note: There are enough cards for 53 players, making this a great game to play with another classroom! You may need to distribute more than one card to some students or play the cards yourself if you have less than 53 students. Alternatively, you may pair students if you have more than 53 students.
- Notice the numbered squares in the corner of each card. If students get stuck, you can find the next card by asking the students who has the next number on the card. You can also refer to the answer key if needed.

#### Directions for play:

- The first player reads card #1) ("We are Starting! Who has all?")
- All players listen to the first person and check their cards to see if their cards answers the first person's question ("I have all. Who has am?")
- Play continues until all cards have been read. The final card signals the end of the game ("I have yes. That's the end!")
