

Retell and Summarize

Tell what happened first, next, then, and last.

Remember to use the names of the characters in your book.

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Draw a picture of the most important part in the book that you read today. Write a sentence about your picture.

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Name a problem that you read about today. Tell how the problem was solved.

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Think about the main character in your book. List all of the things you know about the main character.

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Name 3 things you learned while reading today.

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Tell who your book was about, what happened, where it happened, when it happened, and why it happened.

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Use 10 words or less to explain why it is important to retell and summarize what you read.

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Write a news article about one of the events in your book. Remember to include details, a picture, and a caption.

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Write a list of settings in your book and one event that happened at each setting.

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How do you decide what information to include when you retell a story?

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How do you decide what information to include when you retell nonfiction?

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Write a tweet (140 characters or less) summarizing your book.

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Write a persuasive book review summarizing the story you read today.

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Make a timeline of the events in the book that you read today.

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Make a character map showing how all of the characters in your book know each other.

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What genre did you read today? How do you know?

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What was the theme of the story that you read today?

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What is the main idea of the book that you read today? How do you know?
